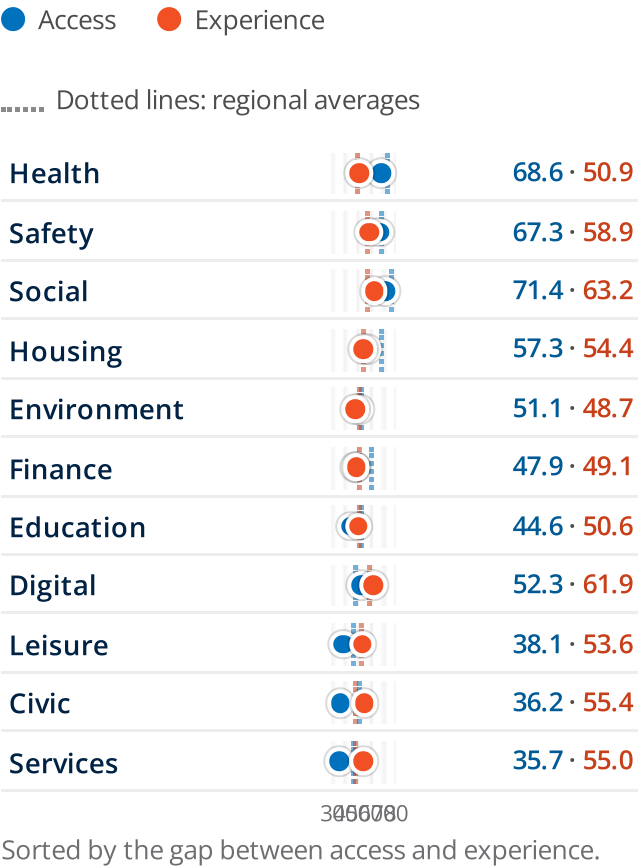

Egypt: experience runs ahead of access in most domains



Index 53.3, near the regional mean, with experience above access (54.7 and 51.8). Egypt records the lowest access index in the sample; experience exceeds recorded access by 19 points on civic participation and on services. Access, not satisfaction, is where the deficit lies.

- Where access most exceeds experience

 - Health and care +17.7
 - Safety and policing +8.4
 - Family and social relationships +8.2
- Experience furthest ahead of access

 - Service provision and assistance -19.3
 - Civic participation and voice -19.2
 - Leisure and community participation -15.5
