Index 46.7, below the regional mean, access 52.9 and experience 40.4, the lowest experience in the sample. Iraq is last on digital access, safety, health and family relationships; civic participation and housing are closer to the regional mean.

Where access most exceeds experience

- Family and social relationships +34.3
- Health and care +27.9
- Leisure and community participation +20.4

Experience furthest ahead of access

- Digital access and use -3.0
- Safety and policing +0.6
- Environmental conditions +4.6
