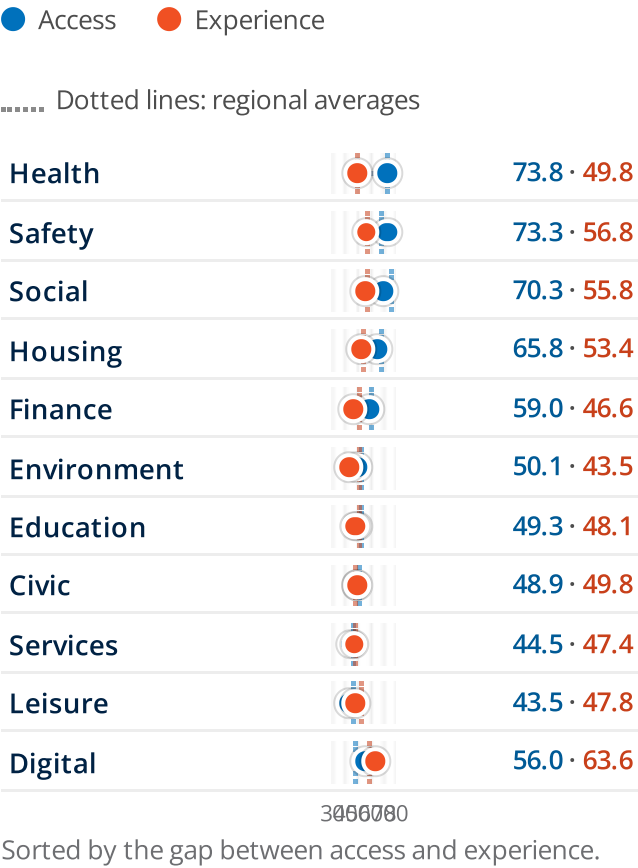

Jordan: access most exceeds experience in health and care



Index 54.4, near the regional mean, with access above the regional mean (57.7 against 57.1) and experience at it (51.1 against 51.3). No domain lies more than four points below the regional mean. The gap is widest on health (24.0) and safety (16.5).

- Where access most exceeds experience

 - Health and care +24.0
 - Safety and policing +16.5
 - Family and social relationships +14.5
- Experience furthest ahead of access

 - Digital access and use -7.6
 - Leisure and community participation -4.3
 - Service provision and assistance -2.9
